Umpires Corner:

1) How many shots does it take to win a Singles game.

Answer: It depends on the match! Most singles are 21 shots but 2 wood singles is highest score after 21 ends. Some singles play to over 100 shots! This is a lesson on ensuring you know what you are marking.

2) What is a tied end. (I'm looking for 3 answers!)

Answer 1: When the 2 bowls (from each team) are both touching the jack.

Answer 2: When the 2 bowls are the same distance from the jack.

Answer 3: When the jack is still live but there are no live bowls left on the rink. Yes that does happen!
