

BYE-LAWS as at 1st APRIL 2025

1. The Club Committee has appointed the following sub-committees of the Club as provided for in Section 2.4 of the Constitution:
 - Bar
 - Social
 - Facilities Management
 - Fundraising
 - Recruitment and Retention
 - IT, Public Relations and Media
2. **Availability of Green:** The green will be available for play from the **26th April until the 27th September**. Play can take place from 2pm on Monday, Wednesday and Friday afternoons and from 11am on Tuesday and Thursday mornings until dusk. At weekends the rinks will be available from 10am until dusk.
3. **Priority for Bowling and Use of Rinks:** The following order shall be adhered to: Nationals, Surreys, West Surreys, Leagues, Club Competitions, Club Matches and roll-ups.
4. **Rink Orientation:** The rink orientation is shown on the Rink Diary. It is also displayed in the shed along with the daily Rink colour.
The rink direction, except for “special days” e.g. Finals Day, shall not be changed from the normal practice of alternating week by week. This should be strictly adhered to, unless authorized by a member of the Bowling Committee.
5. **Match Duties:** These are detailed in the Fixture Book and displayed on the noticeboard and must be adhered to.
6. **Setting Up the Rink etc.** All players are requested to arrive early on match days to set up the rinks.
7. **Dress Code:** Dress on the green will be as set out in the rules of Bowls England. Players, Markers and Umpires shall wear smooth soled, heel-less regulation footwear while on the green. For all competitive and representative matches against other clubs, and on other occasions decided by the committee, dress shall be Club shirts with navy below. On all other occasions, except where the committee has decided otherwise, players shall have the option to wear SMART casual clothing. Non-regulation footwear, denim jeans, leggings and collarless shirts are not acceptable. Shorts may be worn, provided they are knee length or below.
8. **Miscellaneous:**
 - (a) Smoking is not allowed on the green or in any area of the clubhouse.
 - (b) The pathway in front of the clubhouse is a public footpath and must be kept clear of all bags, chairs etc. at all times.
 - (c) Dogs are not allowed in the Clubhouse (except for registered Guide Dogs).
 - (d) Under the terms of our bar licence, it is mandatory that we comply with the licensing laws.
Therefore, the following must be adhered to:
 - (i) ALL visiting teams to be signed in ‘en-bloc’ by our Captain of the Day.

(ii) ALL visitors to the Club must be signed in by a Burpham Club Member. THIS INCLUDES: Player(s) from another Club who are here to play in Competitions whether they will be using the bar or not.

(iii) Each Member may only sign in a maximum of two guests at any one time.

(iv) Individual guests of any member are permitted to attend a maximum of 2 social events in any 12-month period. Members' guests may apply to join the club as non-playing members providing that registered member totals are within CASC rules
