Your fundraising and donations really do make a difference - £415 could pay for ten sessions from an Occupational therapist at Phyllis Tuckwell, who will work with patients to recommend adjustments to the way they live, by looking at the relationship between the activities they do every day, the challenges they're facing, and their environment. These adjustments are practical, realistic, and personal to each patient, to help them achieve the breakthroughs they need to elevate their everyday life.

Your donations make it possible for us to continue **supporting over 250 patients, relatives and carers every day** in their own homes, in the community, on our In-Patient unit and at the Beacon Centre in Guildford. The Government/NHS only provide around 25% of our income and without supporters like you we would not be here.
